COSPPac works with Pacific Island stakeholders to analyse and interpret **climate**, oceans and tidal data to produce valuable services for island communities. This information helps island communities to prepare for, and mitigate the impacts of severe **climate**, tidal and oceanographic events.

Our aim is to enhance the capacity of Pacific Islands to manage and mitigate the impacts of **climate** variability and tidal events. We work with stakeholders in the Islands to build tools that can forecast and report on **climate**, tides and the ocean. And work with them to determine how best to communicate this information to communities, businesses and Governments.

COSPPac was preceded by the [Pacific Islands Climate Prediction Project](#) (PICPP), which ran from 2003 to 2012.
