Project Objectives	<p>The report, "Freshwater under Threat – Pacific Islands", written by David Duncan, Regional Environmental Engineer at SPC SOPAC's <a href="#">Water and Sanitation Programme</a>, found that the almost total reliance on rain-fed <a href="#">agriculture</a> across all islands puts economies and livelihoods at risk. Nearly 10% of deaths of children under five in the region are attributable to <a href="#">water</a> related causes; 90% of these deaths, according to the report, can be traced to poor <a href="#">sanitation</a> treatment systems. The challenges facing the region in terms of freshwater resources are immense. Many of these islands have limited <a href="#">water</a> resources, not to mention human, financial and management resources.</p> <p>The report cited <a href="#">water</a> management as one of the greatest challenges to <a href="#">water</a> resource <a href="#">vulnerability</a>, particularly the limited technical and <a href="#">governance</a> capacity partly due to the high emigration of its skilled and educated workers. All Pacific Islands are struggling with Integrated <a href="#">Water</a> Resources Management capacity, according to the report, with only Samoa and Nauru having IWRM <a href="#">policies</a>. These challenges—which are likely to be aggravated by <a href="#">climate change</a>—will require innovative approaches and tailoring solutions that take into account the complex geographical and socioeconomic constraints of each island. There is no one solution and would need a mix of <a href="#">policy</a> intervention and preferred management <a href="#">measures</a>.</p> <p><a href="#">Development Partner - UNEP</a></p>
