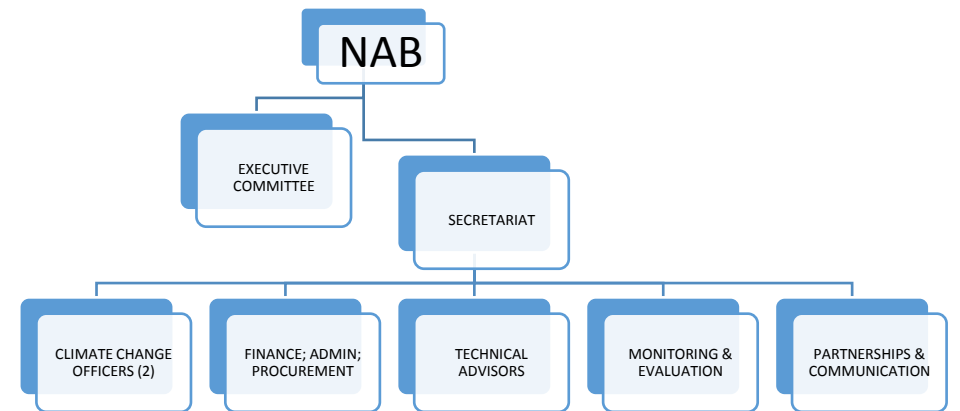
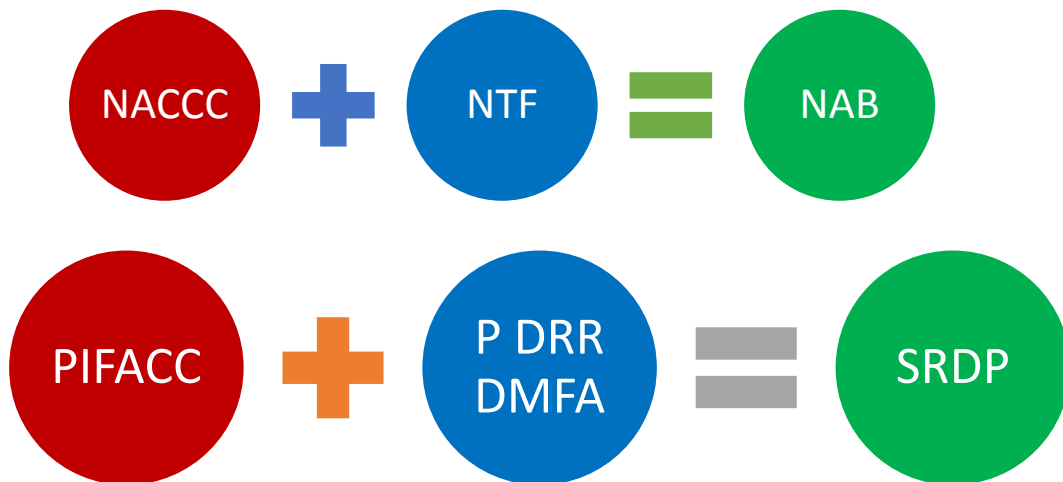
ACHIEVEMENT 1: Prioritising adaptation response needs through adaptation planning processes

- **Significant improvements** to both regional and national adaptation planning processes
- **National:** NAB (Vanuatu), CCTWG (Sol. Is), NCCCT (Samoa)
- **Regional:** SRDP, WARD, DPCC, PACC, GCCA, GIZ ACSE
- **Supporting Programs:** PEIN, Portals (PDN, CC, Ocean)

- National Advisory Board on Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction



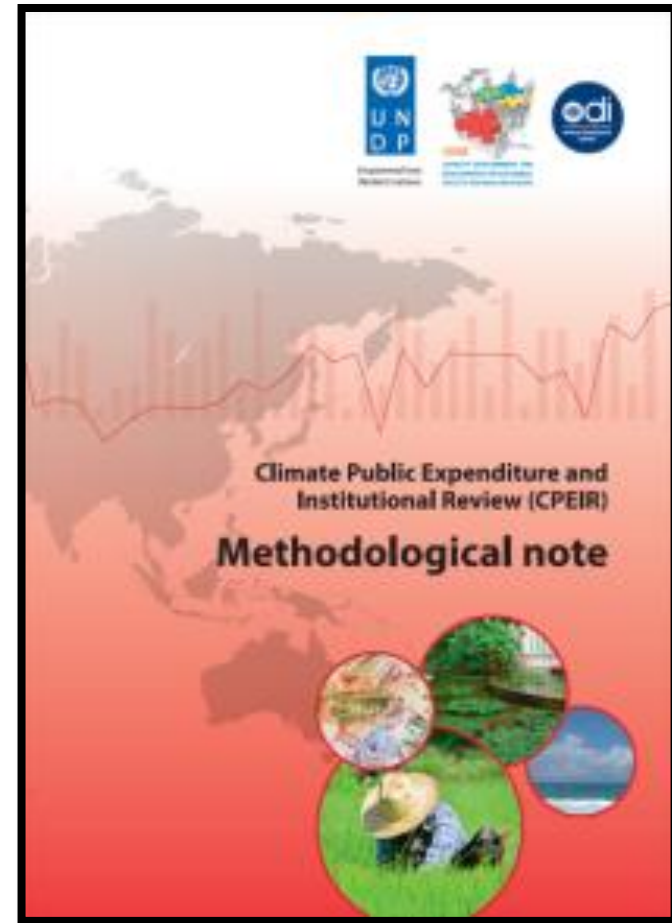
ACHIEVEMENT 1: Prioritising adaptation response needs through adaptation planning processes...

- In areas of: climate finance, gender equality, EbA, mainstreaming, legislation, regulations, partnership, etc



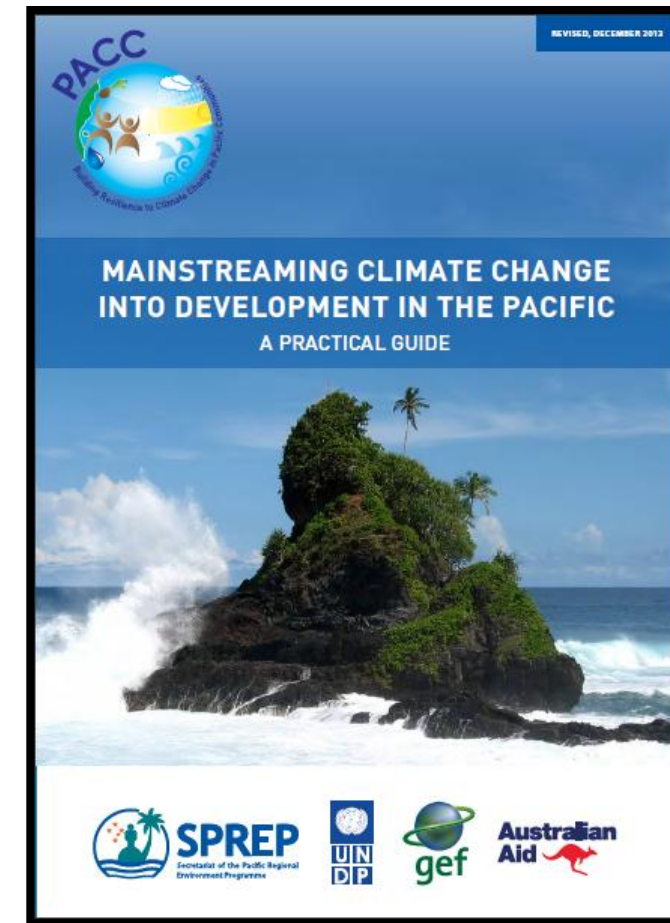
Methodology Example: Climate Finance - Samoa

- To inform the development of the national response to climate change



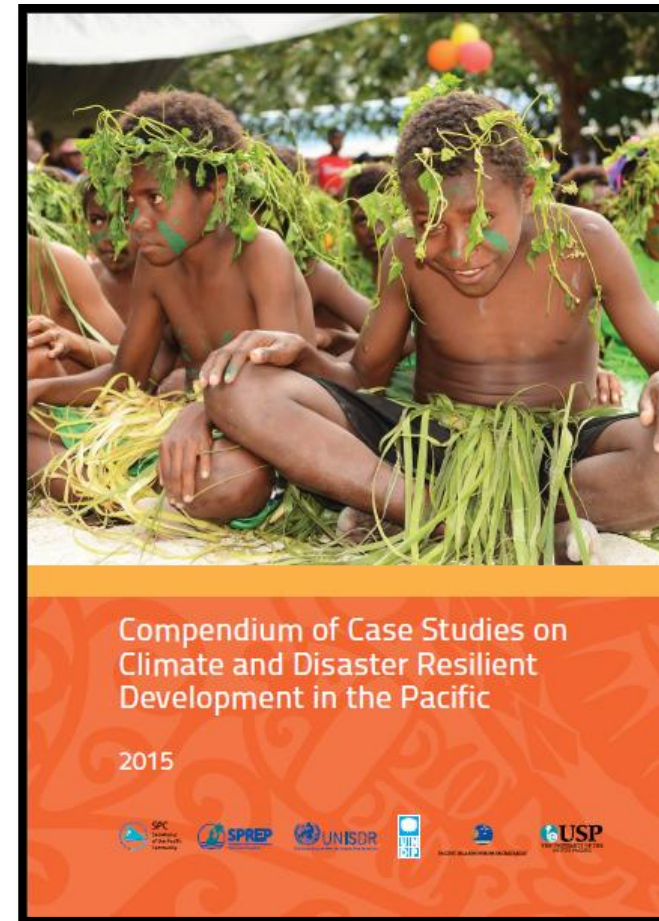
Guide Example: Mainstreaming - Regional

(PICTs)



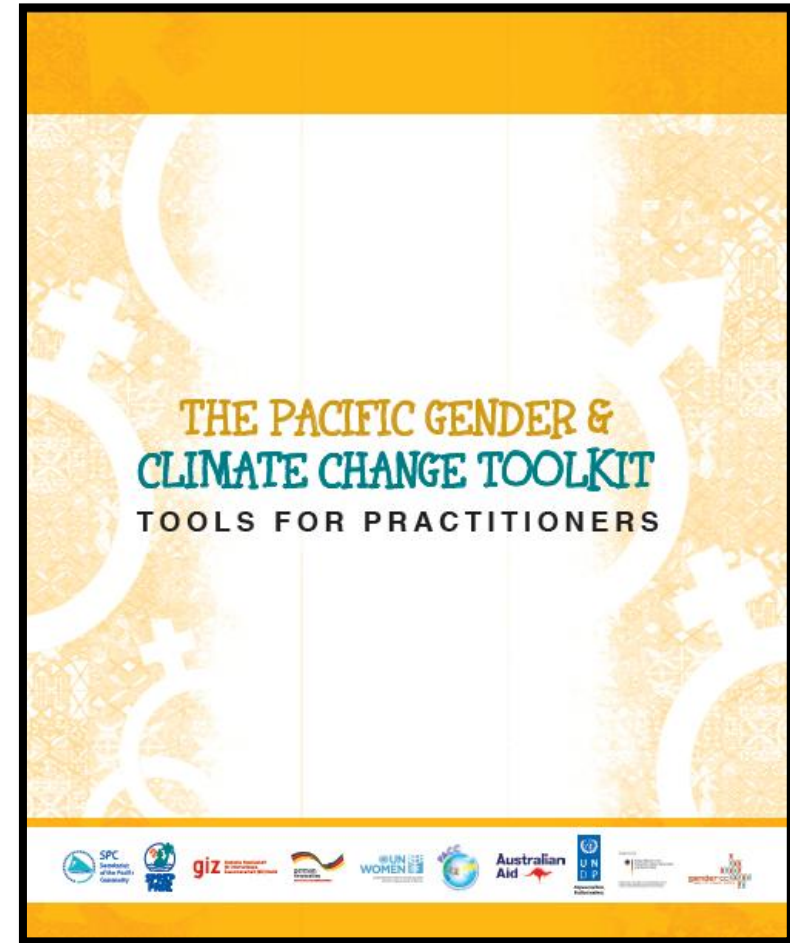
Compendium Example: Climate & Disaster Resilient

ACHIEVEMENT 2: Promote links between education & knowledge generated through field work experience



- **Education resources** on climate change translated to local languages in **Fijian, Samoan, Tongan, Kiribati Tuvaluan** – SPC, SPREP, USP, SEREAD, UNESCO, PREL, RED CROSS, GIZ, USAID, Australia
- **Samoa, Victoria University, GIZ** invested in educational activities that link **tourism and adaptation** – CCCPIR Program
- **Griffith University, SPREP** developed a regional program to enhance the **discovery, accessibility and utilization** of CC information & data.

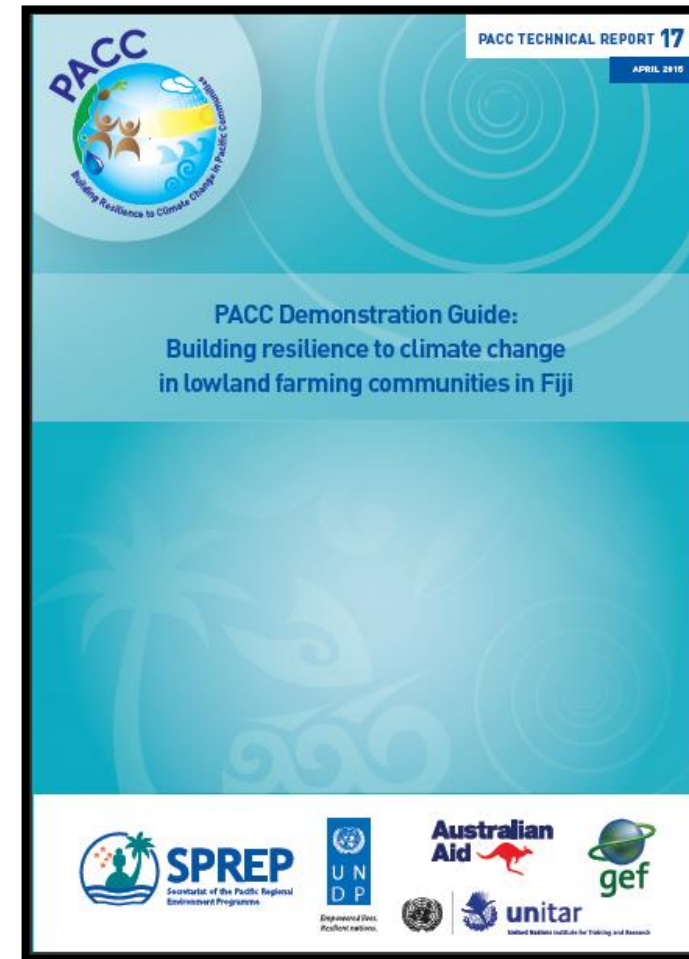
ACHIEVEMENT 3: Science and social science to inform adaptation work
