

ACHIEVEMENT 1: Prioritising adaptation response needs through adaptation planning processes


- Significant improvements to both regional and national adaptation planning processes

- **Supporting Programs:** PEIN, Portals (PDN, CC, Ocean)






National Level Example: Vanuatu NAB


- Methodologies, guides, case studies, toolkits, reviews and approaches have been developed and enhanced and has improved planning significantly

Methodology Example: Climate Finance - Samoa


- Samoa's Climate Public Expenditure and Institutional Review (CPEIR)
- To inform the development of the national response to climate change






Guide Example: Mainstreaming - Regional

Compendium Example: Climate & Disaster Resilient


- showcases programmes and projects that address climate and disaster risks, through CCA, DRM and or GHG emissions reduction.

ACHIEVEMENT 2: Promote links between education & knowledge generated through field work experience




- Education resources on climate change translated to local languages in Fijian,






