


The Programme

- Objective: Enhance sustainable livelihoods through strengthened capacity to adapt to climate change and to enhance energy security
- Country driven approach
- > Call for Proposals to 15 PACP countries in 2014
- 2015-2016: Detailed assessment and planning of 22 projects (10 CCA, 12 SE); signing of agreements; start of projects
- > The last project has started implementation in March 2017













Solar Energy & Energy Efficiency

- > In various stages of planning and tendering:
- Solar and solar hybrid power systems in Kiribati, Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Fiji, Timor-Leste and PNG
- Solar freezer in Vanuatu; medical solar cooler in Fiji
- Training equipment for solar technicians in Solomon Islands
- Solar streetlights in PNG
- Energy efficiency upgrade of government buildings, net-meters in FSM
- > Solar pumps for irrigation were set up in Timor-Leste
- > Energy efficiency assessment of school in Solomon Islands



Biogas and Biomass Systems

- In various stages of planning:
- 2 biogas systems for schools in Vanuatu
- A biomass gasification demonstration plant in Samoa (will be combined with IMPRESS project's larger plant)
- > 6 of 40 biogas systems set up in Tuvalu



- Update of provincial and village development plans
- Infrastructure management plans & agreements

- Nauru Energy Bill
- Vanuatu Aquaculture development plans
- FSM Net Metering Legislation and Energy Bill
- > About 13 of 42 plans integrating CCA created or updated
- > Samoa Energy Sector Plan released
- > Fiji relocation guidelines close to completion




Water and Sanitation



- > In various stages of planning, tendering and construction:
- Water tanks in RMI, Cook Islands, FSM, PNG
- Water pumps, pipes and water collection points in PNG
- Sewage tanks in Niue
- Coastal Vegetation in Tonga
- Rainwater collection systems, 60.000 | Water tank, solar pump, pipes, and 12 drip irrigation systems setup in Timor-Leste
- 3 of 6 rainwater collection systems with drip irrigation and nipples for pigs setup in Palau
- > Leaking pipes fixed in Solomon Island



Food Security and Sustainable Livelihoods



- > In various stages of planning, tendering and construction:
- 3 trial fish farms, a fish hatchery upgrade, and a biogas fed school kitchen in Vanuatu
- 512 of 500 planned cooking stoves setup and 11.500 trees planted in Timor-Leste
- > 3 of 5 piggeries built in Palau
- 8 of 9 food production systems improved in Fiji
 Fruit trees, climate resilient crops, piggeries, poultry,
 beehives

Coastal Protection & Relocation

- > In various phases of planning and tendering:
- Mangrove Planting, Sea Wall and Groins in Tonga
- Construction of 7 houses and a school for relocation in Fiji

> 3 Automated Weather Stations setup in Vanuatu

Education & Training

Sustainable Energy

Examples: Energy conservation, Solar technicians training, PV powered irrigation systems, Operation & Maintenance *about 3 of 23 trainings completed*

Climate Change Adaptation & Sustainable Livelihoods


Examples: GIS coastal vulnerability, Land use mapping, Rainwater irrigation systems, Climate Field School, Mangrove and Tree Planting, Climate Change Awareness, Hygiene Awareness, Sustainable Livelihoods (honey, carpentry, crops, etc.) *about 15 of 40 trainings completed*






Gender

- > A Gender Workshop in Kiribati
- A number of gender-sensitive consultations, trainings and workshops in Timor-Leste, Tonga and Fiji
- Gender actions included in Tonga JNAPII
- > 3 of 4 Gender Analyses completed in Kiribati and Palau
