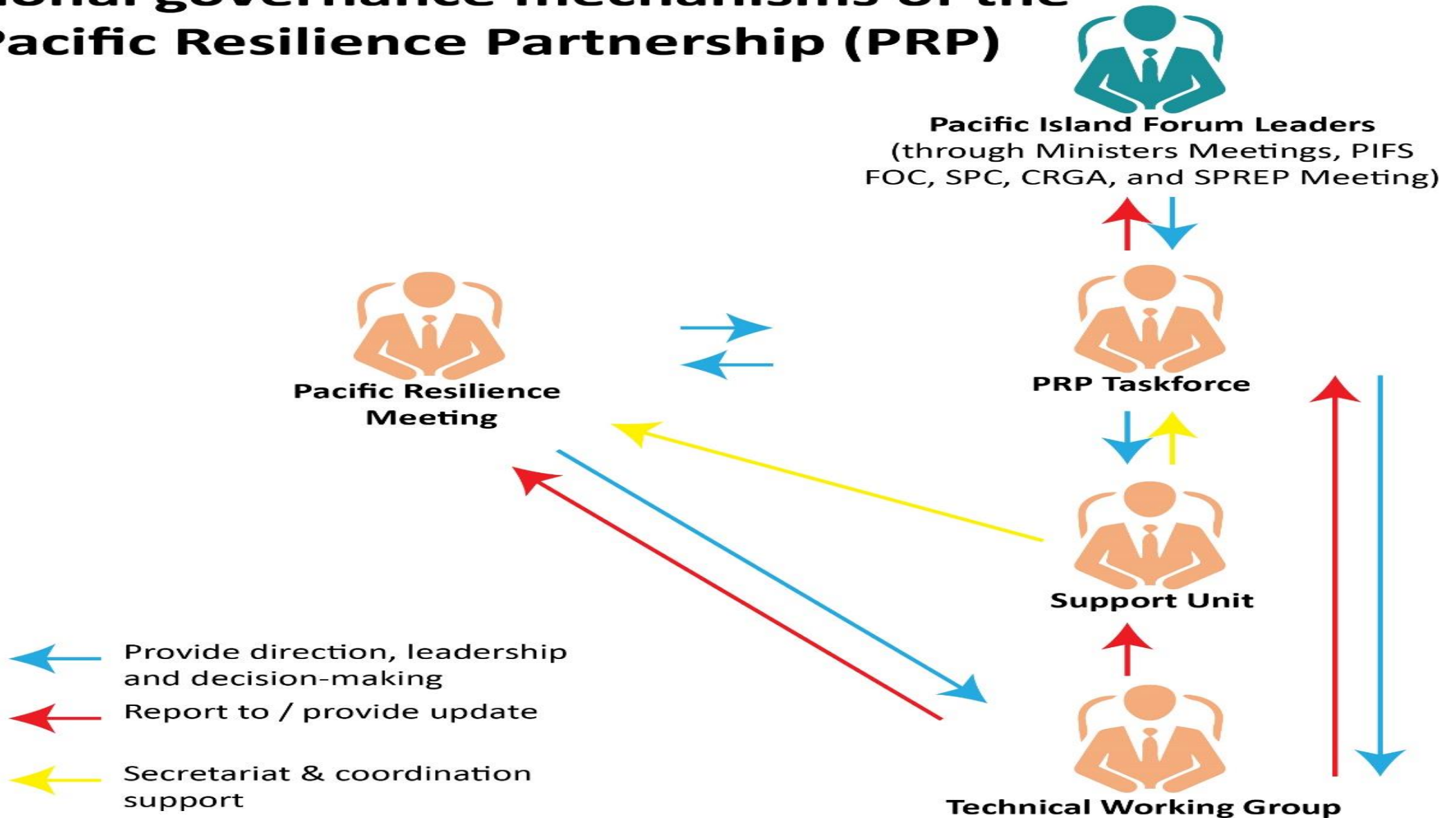

- Affiliation between the Hub, Partnership and the PRP.

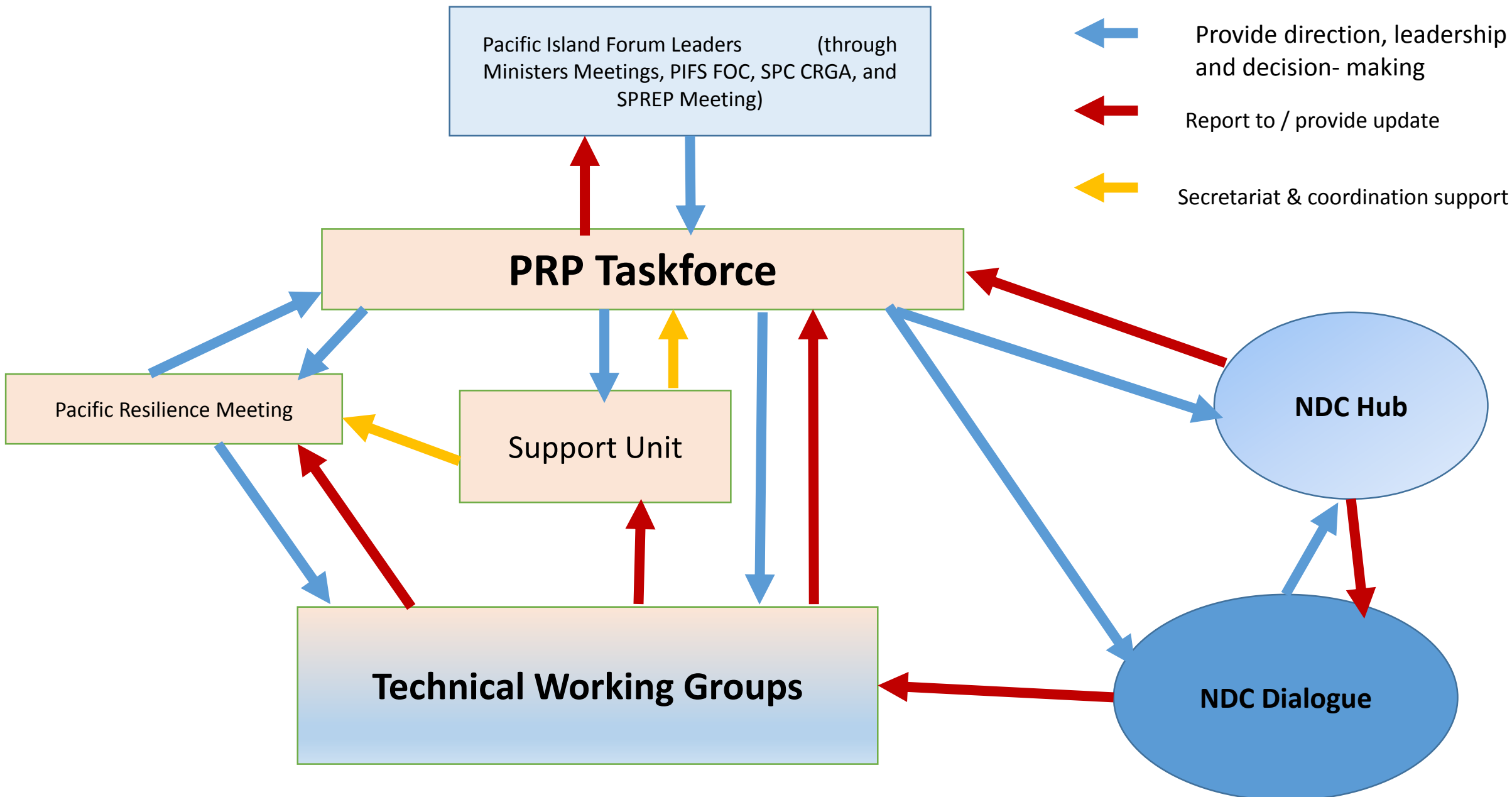
How?

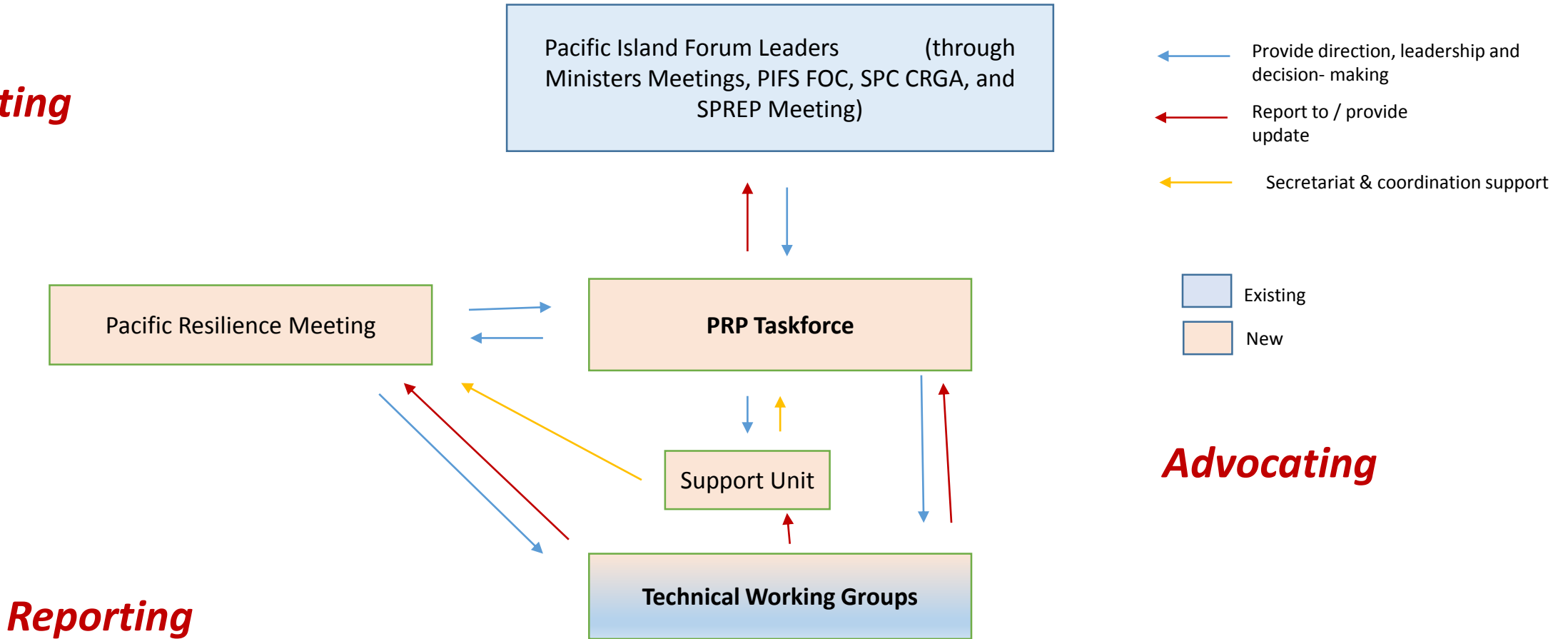
