

# **Summary of outcomes - NDC Hub Focal Points Meeting**

- Positive, open and transparent discussions
- Willingness to work collaboratively to overcome initial delays
- Immediate priorities:
  - Appointment of a Hub Coordinator: The ToR for the position should be shared with the focal points for their dissemination.
  - Progress the development of a knowledge management system to facilitate information sharing
  - Review the country request process in line with recommendations provided as part of this meeting as part of Phase II planning



# Recommendations to improve the country request process included:


- Development of further guidance to accompany the country request form
- Additional support to progress assistance from the initial request stage to a fully-fledged Scope of Works or Terms of Reference that could be used as the basis for recruiting and providing technical assistance.
- More engagement and regular communication by Hub partners and countries
- Countries re-emphasised that experts from the region should be used where possible
- Timely notification of meetings and trainings
- Also recommended to complement the country request mechanism with other training, knowledge exchange and learning opportunities.



## The following next steps were identified:

- Further consultations on the communications strategy with a view to finalization by October 2019
- Specific trainings on Article 6, media and NDCs were requested and will be coordinated with SPREP as part of their pre-COP training.
- A Steering Committee meeting is scheduled for August 2019 and a Phase II
  planning meeting later in the year.




## Value Proposition



Figure 2: Timeline for key NDC and transparency-related processes under the Paris Agreement






Collective Leadership for Accelerated NDC Implementation

# The NDCFI in a nutshell: A non-traditional platform including governments, the private sector, and development partners

Advances and accelerates the implementation of Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) in the Caribbean region and related commitments of OECS Member States (MS) that are not individually party to the UNFCCC.

Supports ambitions for climate leadership and catalyzes investments in resilient and low-carbon infrastructure.

Offers learning and support opportunities that: - address hurdles in the development of **investment projects**, - improve access to **public and private climate finance**, and - help close the gap on **support needs** inscribed as conditions for the full implementation of NDCs.

Enables collaboration and offers opportunities to consolidate resources and develop economies of scale.

The NDCFI approach is consistent with a mandate from the OECS Council of Ministers for Environment and supported by a Ministerial Declaration signed at the inaugural NDCFI Forum held in Saint Lucia in October 2018.

# A snapshot of what's been going on since the inaugural Forum in October 2018


- Training workshop on the use of the **online project management platform SOURCE** for the preparation and management of climate projects.
- Advancing project ideas to the concept note stage for consideration by the Green Climate Fund (GCF) or Adaptation Fund (AF).
- Working Groups (WGs) established on Energy, Water (including Transport), and Other Critical Infrastructure.
- Collaboration with GET.invest, an EU-funded support instrument for mobilizing renewable energy investments.
- Planning a 2<sup>nd</sup> NDC Finance Forum to be held in March 2020. In pursuit of the NDCFI's mission to catalyze climate investment and its ambition to expand private climate financing, the NDCFI has partnered with GET.invest as well as the Private Financing Advisory Network (PFAN) and IRENA to jointly host a climate finance week for the Caribbean and Central America and integrate their established investment forum and investor matchmaking formats.
- A review of **planned and ongoing NDC revision** is focusing on identifying opportunities for policy harmonization and other concrete opportunities for regional collaboration and financing, including options for institutionalizing a centralized data collection and reporting mechanism.
- A regional needs-based climate finance strategy for the OECS is being developed in partnership with the UNFCCC's Needs Based Climate Finance (NBF) project to identify further opportunities for regional action and resource mobilization.






