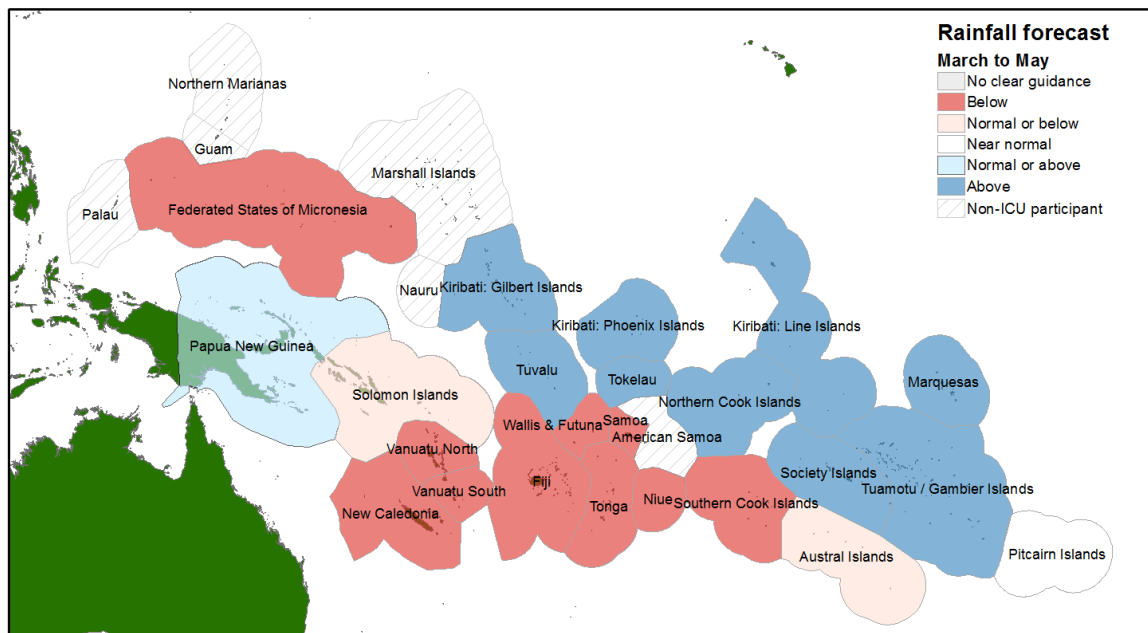

## March to May 2016 rainfall forecast



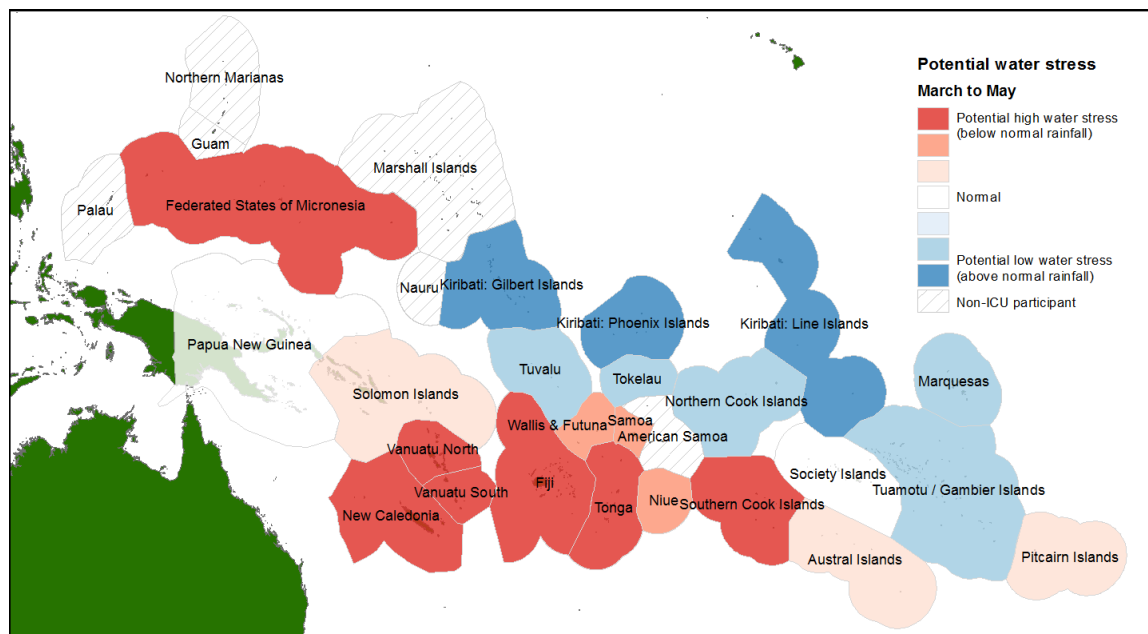
## Regional drought potential advisory

Based on rainfall anomaly classification over the past six months and forecast rainfall anomaly classification over the next 3 months

**New Caledonia, Vanuatu, Southern Cooks Islands:** Below to well below normal rainfall experienced over 5 of the past 6 months. Below normal rainfall is forecast over the next 3 months.

**Fiji, Tonga, Federated States of Micronesia :** Below to well below normal rainfall experienced over 4 of the past 6 months. Below normal rainfall is forecast over the next 3 months.

**Niue, Samoa, Wallis & Futuna:** Below to well below normal rainfall experienced over 3 of the past 6 months. Below normal rainfall is forecast over the next 3 months.
